

# TABLE OF CHARGES

## Cemeteries and Crematorium



### Part 1 – interments

The fees are for digging of the grave to a depth of up to 2,400mm where indicated but do not include the cost of removal of kerbs, railings and memorials, which must be carried out in proper time by the owner. Failing such removal, the service will not be able to proceed. Only biodegradable coffins must be used.

For the interment, in a grave, in respect of which an exclusive right of burial has been granted

Description	Fee
The body of a still-born child, or a child whose age at the time of death did not exceed 18 years - an application will be made to the Children's Funeral Fund by the Bereavement Service.	Free
The body of a person whose age at the time of death exceeded 18 years.	£1491

For the interment, in a grave, in respect of which an exclusive right of burial has **not** been granted

Description	Fee
The body of a still-born child, or a child whose age at the time of death did not exceed 18 years - an application will be made to the Children's Funeral Fund by the Bereavement Service.	Free
The body of a person whose age at the time of death exceeded 18 years.	£982

Please note: In the case of new graves where coffins are in excess of 750mm (29.5") wide the charge will be one and a half normal interment fee and double the exclusive right of burial fee. In the case of reopen graves where coffins are in excess of 750mm (29.5") wide the charge will be one and a half normal interment fee and subject to the availability of widening the existing grave.

### Part 2 - exclusive right of burial in earthen graves

For the exclusive right of burial in an earthen grave granted to:

Description	Fee
100 years	£2426
50 years	£1512
25 years	£882
For the renewal of an exclusive right of burial prior to April 1951, the annual fee of	£34

**Part 3 - monuments, gravestones, tablets and monumental inscriptions**

For the right to erect or place on a grave for the period of the exclusive right of burial (this charge is for the right only and does not include the cost of providing or erecting monuments etc.)

The fees below include the first inscription.

Description	Fee
A memorial on a bearing stone, not exceeding 900mm in height and 900mm by 600mm	£210
A memorial not on a bearing stone and not exceeding 300mm in height and 600mm by 450mm	£95
A bronze plaque, 450mm by 225mm to be laid flat on grave	£95
A vase, not exceeding 300mm in height by 225mm	£79
0 – 18 years: permission to erect a memorial - an application will be made to the Children's Funeral Fund by the Bereavement Service if died on or after 23 July 2019.	Free

For each inscription after the first, a fee of £74 applies.

**Part 1 - cremation**

For the cremation of:

Description	Fee
A still-born child or a child whose age at the time of death did not exceed 18 years - an application will be made to the Children's Funeral Fund by the Bereavement Service.	Free *
A person whose age at the time of death exceeds 18 years – 30 minute service	£1125 *
A person whose age at the time of death exceeds 18 years – 45 minute service	£1230 *
A person whose age at the time of death exceeds 18 years – 90 minute service	£1630 *
A person whose age at the time of death exceeds 18 years - no cremation service with up to 4 mourners in attendance	£770 *
A person whose age at the time of death exceeds 18 years - no cremation service with no one in attendance	£550 *

\* Inclusive of scattering fee or supply of transit container and certificate for cremated remains.

Please note: The coffin is to be constructed in accordance with the requirements of the Environmental Protection Act 1992. Specification can be obtained from the cemetery office.

**Part 2 - columbarium and colonnade at the cemeteries**

Rows of niches designated by appropriate letters are shown on the plan of the columbarium.

**Columbarium**

For the exclusive use of a niche in the columbarium for 25 years:

Description	Fee
Rows C to E at Efford and A to J at Weston Mill	£1502
Rows A, B, F to L at Efford and K to M at Weston Mill	£1229

For the renewal of a niche for a further period of 25 years:

Description	Fee
Rows C to E at Efford and A to J at Weston Mill	£494
Rows A, B, F to L at Efford and K to M at Weston Mill	£383

For the closure of a niche at the expense of the lessee by a stone tablet on which may be placed an inscription on request for £74

**Part 3 - burial of cremated remains**

For the exclusive right of burial of cremated remains in a Burial Plot (an earthen grave), suitable for two interments:

For a period of 25 years renewable	£688
For a period of 50 years renewable	£971
For the interment of cremated remains in a burial plot	£210
The right for a stonemason to erect a sloping block of natural stone 450mm x 300mm	£95
For each inscription after the first	£74
For the renewal of a Burial Plot for a 25 year period	£688
For the renewal of a Burial Plot for a 50 year period	£971

For the exclusive right of burial of cremated remains in a sanctum (below ground) vault, suitable for two interments:

Description	Fee
For a period of 25 years renewable, including first interment	£1008
For a period of 50 years renewable, including first interment	£1260
Subsequent interment	£210
Replacement tablet	£210
Refurbishment of tablet	£79
